



Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure

## **Selection Procedure – Greece**

Greek National Young Physicists' Tournament is called "IYPT Hellas". Hellenic Physical Society (EEF) is responsible for organizing an event for the selection of the Greek team members.

Registration begins on August, after the problems are published. Students all over Greece can form teams from 3 to 5 students and start working on the problems. It is not necessary that a team consists of students from the same school. Students must be at the proper age, from 12 to 17 years old (High school students), both from private and public schools. Students of a different nationality that study in schools (private or public) in Greece have also the right to participate.

In December a first meeting and workshop is organized by EEF at one of the two main cities (Athens or Thessaloniki). Teams present their work at 7 of the problems (EEF decides in advance which of the problems will be presented).

In April, there is the final "IYPT Hellas" event and lasts 2-3 days. Each team will participate in 3 fights. The teams must be prepared for all of the problems. The Greek committee selects 5 of the best students to represent the country in IYPT. EEF has the right to invite experienced jurors to help selecting the best students for the task. An invitation to international teams is optional, if needed.
