

Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure

SELECTION PROCEDURE – IYPT SOUTH AFRICA:

- At present, the team we are sending to the IYPT is a **“Team from South Africa”** as opposed to a **“South African Representative Team”**. We make this distinction since South Africa currently does not have a national competition structure for selecting IYPT participants. National science competitions in South Africa are organised by ASTEMI (<http://www.astemi.co.za>), which is not willing to provide any funding for such a structure at present as they are already running a multitude of science and technology-focused competitions. As a result, we have to initiate participation in a private capacity with a long-term objective to expand the effort nationally.
- In future our team will comprise of 5 senior Physics students from Parklands College, an independent high school in Cape Town, South Africa (<http://www.parklands.co.za/>) and St John's College, an independent high school in Johannesburg (<http://www.stjohnscollege.co.za>). I am currently the Head of Science at Parklands College and Dr Alistair Douglas is a professional Physicist and a Senior Physical Sciences teacher at St John's College.
- We are selecting our team based on the following criteria:
 - The academic merit of our students in the Physical Science subject offering.
 - The merit of our senior students in the National Science Fair (<https://www.exposcience.co.za/>).
 - The merit of their performance in their Senior Science Research Project in Grade 11 at Parklands College.
 - The merit of their solutions to the officially published IYPT problems. These will be assessed early next year, after which a team will be selected.
- Using the two schools as IYPT centres in Johannesburg and Cape Town, we plan to grow IYPT in South Africa to other schools and set up a formal ZAYPT (ZA = Zuid Afrika “.co.za” is our official ending for emails and websites in South Africa) in the next few years.
