Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure

Turkish IYPT Team Selection Procedure

The team to represent Turkey in IYP1 (Referred to as "the team" hereinafter) is, and will be composed of 5 students. Galatasaray High School will do its best to accommodate the candidates' and the students' needs with respect to participation procedures at any stage of the selection process.

The rules and regulations for candidates:

- 1. The candidates are required to have Turkish citizenship or a Turkish residency permit.
- 2. The candidates should be enrolled at high school, or graduated within 120 days of the given year's IYPT dates.
- 3 The selection procedure is, and will be available and accessible for every student complying with articles 1 and
- 4. The candidates are expected to communicate their work fluently in English.

The selection procedure:

- 1 All candidates, regardless of their affiliation with any team, should submit their solutions to at least one of the problems selected by Galatasaray High School by the announced deadline.
- 2. Upon the successful qualification of the reports, max. 25 students will be selected. These students will be invited to submit a 10-minute long video, in which they will be presenting their solution to one of the problems selected by Galatasaray High School.
- 3. The work of the participants will be evaluated by a jury selected and invited by Galatasaray High School. The jury is expected to have relevant qualifications to IYPT (e.g. degree in physics/physical sciences, prior participation in the IYPT etc.) 3 teams of 5 students will be selected and invited to realize a physics fight after the evaluation of video submissions.
- 4. If needed, the jury can decide to perform a written and/or oral exam after the physics fights. Participating teams might be split up for the final team decisions.
- 5. The final team composition will be decided by the designated members of the jury. In the final verdict, participants' performance in the physics fight, the scientific quality of the reports, participants' ability to collaborate and cooperate as well as their communication skills will be taken into account.
